Certified Health Care Physical Environment Worker (ASHE Worker Certification)



IT'S AS EASY AS ADDING IT TO YOUR BID SPECS

The following example is based on the American Institute of Architects document A201-2017 General Conditions of the Contract for Construction. Similar language can be included in Associated General Contractors documents or any customized construction document.

Example: A201-2017 General Conditions of the Contract for Construction

REVISE § 3.4.3 The Contractor shall enforce strict discipline and good order among the Contractor's employees and other persons carrying out the Work. All employees and other persons carrying out the work shall possess a valid Certified Health Care Physical Environment Worker certification from the American Society for Health Care Engineering. The Contractor shall not permit employment of unfit persons or persons not properly skilled in tasks assigned to them.

ASHE's newest certification ensures that everyone working on the job site understands the complexities of a health care project. ASHE recommends that organizations require job site workers to participate in ASHE's Certified Health Care Physical Environment Worker program.

- Ensure your construction team understands how to work in a health care environment upon arrival
- Minimize risks on the job site to protect patients and staff
- Save time and resources for job site orientation training

- Earned by completing an online 75-question multiple choice exam
- Certification is valid for 3 years upon passing the exam
- Certification holders will receive a badge showing your name and photo, and a hard hat sticker
